Advent 1

As someone lights the first candle, another prays:

Advent 2

As someone lights the first two candles, another prays:

God of creation, whose Son took on humanity without losing divinity: Help us never lose our awe and wonder at the ways in which you love us, that, as Christ came to live like us, we might live like Christ; who with you and the Holy Spirit is worshiped and glorified. **Amen**.

Reader: Let the same mind be in us that was in Christ Jesus.

All: Thanks be to God.

Advent 3

As someone lights the first three candles, another prays:

God of Love, who lives as the mysterious relationship of the Trinity: Give us the grace to welcome all into a living relationship with the body of Christ, that the light of your gospel of love may continue to shine bright on earth as it is in heaven; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.

Reader: Love will enlighten the nations.

All: Thanks be to God.

Advent 4

As someone lights all four candles, another prays:

God of hope, whose Son came to bring salvation to the world: Give us the peace that passes understanding, secure in the knowledge that, as Christ came once, so Christ will come again, that we may continue the work of spreading the love that binds together the kingdom of God; through Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, now and forever. **Amen**.

Reader: Christ will come again.

All: Thanks be to God.
